



CENSUS 2022 IMPORTANT DATES

SDIs, transient and the
homeless populations
counted on Census Night
of 2 February 2022.




- 3 to 14 January: Training of Field Operations Officers (FOOs).
- 15 to 30 January: Training of Fieldworkers.
- 5 February: Registration for online and telephonic registration closes.
- 31 January: Census 2022 Recruitment closes.
- 2 February: Census Night (homeless, transient, SDIs get counted).
- 3 February: Data collection and Telephonic Data collection starts.
- 15 February: Online completion of Census questionnaire.
- 28 February: Collection Ends.
- 1 to 9 March: Mop Up.
- 14 March to 26 April: Post Enumeration Survey (PES)

CENSUS 2022 FACT BOX




- 2022 is Census Year.
- Over 10 years since the last Census in 2011.
- Only digital devices will be used to collect data for Census 2022.
- Remote data collection is available, participate from anywhere and at own convenience (within remote data collection timelines).
- Census Fieldworkers are recruited via online methods only.
- Census Fieldworkers can be verified online and telephonically.
- Data collected during Census cannot be shared with other state departments.
- Stats Act requires everyone to provide data during a census when requested to do so.
- Only one person per household should complete the census questionnaire.

HOUSEHOLDS WHO REGISTER CHOOSE HOW TO FILL THE CENSUS QUESTIONNAIRE

VISIT



A fieldworker visits households and administers the census questionnaire on a hand-held device with the respondent.

A link will be sent via cellphone or email to complete the census questionnaire. The link will be provided to households after registering for this collection mode.

A confirmation of registration is sent to indicate that respondents will be called by a Stats SA clerk on specific dates.

A clerk will call on the specified date and administer the questionnaire via the telephone with the respondent.

#GETCOUNTED

THE BENEFITS OF REGISTERING FOR CENSUS 2022



Respondents get to choose an option for their preferred mode of completing Census Questionnaire – online, by telephone, or to be visited by a Census fieldworker.



If you choose online questionnaire completion, you get to do this datafree at your own convenience anywhere you are — within the predetermined dates.



If you opted for telephonic questionnaire completion, then you can choose the time that is convenient to you during which a Stats SA official will call you to complete the questionnaire.



If you prefer to be visited by a census fieldworker, the questionnaire completion will be conducted at the comfort of your own home – with strict adherence to the COVID-19 protocols by Stats SA fieldstaff.

HOW TO IDENTIFY CENSUS 2022 FIELDWORKERS

Call Center also available to verify fieldworkers

The fieldworker/s:

- Will always wear a MASK (with the Census logo on it) and maintain social distance;
- Will carry a Census ID card which you can verify;
- Will wear a Census BIB with the Census logo on it;
- Will carry a Census BAG with the Census logo on it;
- Will carry a Census TABLET with a cover that has the Census logo on it.



#GETCOUNTED

ENCOURAGE AND ASSIST ALL RESIDENTS TO #GETCOUNTED

- Welcome census field staff and engage them to learn more about the census.
- Distribute Census 2022 pamphlets within your complex/estate.
- Share Census 2022 digital posters on residents WhatsApp group.
- Put up posters on the notice board.
- Share the registration link on the WhatsApp group.
- Verify the identity of fieldworkers assigned to your area.
- Allow fieldworkers access where required.
