LABOUR STRIKE AT TRANSNET

We have received notification that the South African Transport and Allied Workers Union (Satawu) and United National Transport Union (Untu) have issued notification of protected strike action across Transnet affecting all divisions. This after failed wage negotiations that have been weeks in the process of negotiation. As it stands, Untu has commenced strike action on Thursday 6 October and at this stage Satawu on Monday 10 October. Transnet is scheduled to meet with Satawu on Friday 7 October to schedule a new wage offer and has also lodged an urgent interdict against Untu to be heard on Friday 7 October. Subject to the offer being accepted, Satawu will continue strike action as planned, should the new offer be rejected. Transnet has since issued notice of Force Majeure against the strike action. The CGA will continue joining the daily Transnet port operations meetings and will provide regular updates as and when we learn more.
